We will not publish translated articles, interviews, criticism, or translation didactics. That is, we do not intend to translate, edit, teach translation, criticise or evaluate translations. Instead, we want to do researches, write reviews and carry out surveys on all translation issues: cultural, historical, linguistic, literary, technological, etc.

By submitting a paper to the *Translation Studies*, the authors represent that their text and any illustrations thereto comply with national and international copyright laws. The authors release and hold the *Translation Studies* harmless from any claims or liabilities under such laws. Quotations from any article published herein are permitted as long as proper reference is clearly made to the *Translation Studies* as the original source.

### Style

- Length: Normally between 3000 and 4,500 words.
- Style: APA
- Format: Microsoft Word is preferred. Graphics can be in TIFF, JPEG, GIF, Photoshop, or BMP.
- References: Documentation in text and notes should be supported by a list of works cited
- Non-English quotations should be followed immediately in the text by a translation in [brackets].
